NLA is back with another edition of our “In the Limelight” series. This time, we are featuring our associate member, ClimeCo.

ClimeCo serves all industries but specializes in helping hard-to-abate sectors advance decarbonization. Their suite of sustainability solutions includes sustainability advisory, environmental credits (also known as environmental attribute certificates), carbon project development, regulatory compliance and policy advisory, certification programs, digital carbon solutions, and insetting.

declarations, enabling transparent reporting for end-use markets such as construction, steel, and water treatment.

ClimeCo is an active participant in NLA's annual meeting and engages with the industry's decarbonization challenges. ClimeCo CEO Bill Flederbach and NLA Executive Director Bill Herz have a long-standing professional relationship rooted in prior collaboration with The Fertilizer Institute (TFI). Through that partnership, ClimeCo helped bring industry members together to better understand and adopt voluntary N<sub>2</sub>O abatement strategies at nitric acid facilities, supporting education, alignment, and consistent implementation across producers. This collaborative effort demonstrated how industry groups can work together to address complex emissions challenges in a practical and coordinated way.



The experience also helped advance broader recognition of voluntary, market-based approaches as an effective pathway for emissions reductions, while reinforcing the value of trusted relationships between industry associations and technical partners. It remains a strong example of how alignment, transparency, and shared goals can lead to meaningful and lasting progress.
